

# **CCJ: AMENDMENTS TO CCJ PADEL POLICIES**

Dear Members,

Kindly view the below, amended policies which will be implemented from 1 November 2023:

#### **CCJ MEMBERS:**

- R25 per person per hour for weekdays between 10h00 15h00. These are considered "off-peak" times.
- R50 per person per hour for all other time slots, including Saturdays, Sun days and Public Holidays. These are considered "Premium" times.
- All players will be limited to two hours per person per day.
- Padel racquet hire will remain complimentary for members.
- Members are asked to be mindful of their bookings during premium playing times as court space is limited.
- CCJ Management may, at their discretion, permit a member who has fulfilled their daily allotment of play, to fill in and play if there is a requirement due to injury or no-show.

## **GUESTS PLAYING AT CCJ:**

- Guests will continue to be charged R100 per hour per guest.
- Padel racquet hire remains at R50 per guest.
- A member may have one guest at any time, i.e. a court can have a maximum of two guests playing with two members present.
- A guest of a member may only visit the Club twice in a calendar month, as per the general CCJ Club Rules.

## CANCELLATIONS:

- Cancellations must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Failing to do so will result in a cancellation charge of the court hire fee. A no-show charge of R400 will apply if the players do not arrive and the booking is not cancelled.
- The cancellation charge will not apply if the cancelled time is re-booked by another member.

## CHECK-IN

- All players are required to check in at the padel desk prior to playing.
- Members must produce their membership cards on check-in to verify the booking.
- Players are encouraged to arrive a few minutes prior to the commencement of their booking to ensure a smooth check-in and maximum court time usage.

## **COACHING FEES:**

• Coaching rates will be increased, including the new fee structure for court fee requirements. This will be determined by Dean with the approval of Management.



• When the Woodmead courts open, coaching will take place at both properties and Dean will split his time as we deem appropriate to optimise court availability for members.

#### **CCJ PADEL COMMITTEE:**

- A Padel AGM will be held in February 2024.
- In the interim, it has been agreed that Marieta Boshoff and Courtney Pulford will be co-opted onto the Padel Committee.

#### **REVIEW OF THE POLICIES:**

• Six months after the opening of the Woodmead Courts (estimated June 2024) these policies will be reviewed and may be amended as required.

We believe these changes will contribute positively to the overall experience at CCJ. Your cooperation and understanding is greatly appreciated as we implement these revised policies.

Furthermore, we are pleased to report that the refurbishment of the Auckland Park Astroturf is now complete; the courts are looking great and are open for bookings. In addition, the Woodmead Tennis, Padel, Parking and Racquets Pavilion project is going well and is anticipated to open on the 1st December 2023. More information regarding the opening will be distributed in due course.

We thank you for your continued support and look forward to seeing you on the courts.
